On 28th March this year, we lost one of our greatest entertainers in Paul O'Grady, famed for his "For the Love of Dogs" and self titled chat shows. To a modern generation those are what he was known best for. However Paul's career really took hold in 1978 when he invented the one and only Ms Lilly Savage, changing the trajectory of his life and comedy drag for good. As entertaining as Lilly was, she and Paul bore witness to the HIV/AIDS pandemic of the 1980's which cruelly took the lives of thousands. Faced with the injustice of Margaret Thatcher's Tory government

Paul and his compatriots fought back, joining pride marches and performing benefit gigs across the UK alongside visiting aids wards to offer a moment of light and joy amongst the darkness and making a true difference in the march to equality.

Paul was so beloved because he kept it real, and spoke out whenever he saw injustice never scared to be the voice that rose above the parapet when it was needed. Yes he could make us laugh but he also made us think when it counted. We can never thank Paul enough for his contribution to the Pride Movement not only in Edinburgh but across the UK. Just the week before his death, Paul was in Edinburgh performing as Miss Hanigan in Annie at the Edinburgh Playhouse, for those of us who saw those performances its all the more staggering that just three days after the curtain fell on that run Paul was gone.

They don't make them like Paul anymore, he was unique, a true one of a kind, yes he entertained us and often had us rolling with laughter but ultimately he cared and made the difference. To his Husband Andre Portasio his beloved family and friends he is irreplaceable.

Thank you Paul O'Grady for all that you achieved, for making the difference to the LGBTQI+ community and for all the laugher over the years, We at Pride Edinburgh are proud to dedicate our 2023 event to your memory!







#### PRIDE MARCH

12:15: Pride Marchers to assemble at Scottish Parliament on Parliament Green by Horse Wynd.

12.30: Speeches will commence from invited guest speakers atop a Lothian double decker bus.

13:00: Pride March moves off, heading North and turning left into the Canongate, carrying on up to the High Street. Continuing west up the High Street, turning left at Lawnmarket Junction onto George IV Bridge, at the end of George IV Bridge a slight left into Bristo Place, then left again into Potterrow followed by a right turn into Crichton Street.

Finally a right turn into Charles Street, and The Pride March arrives at the EUSA Campus at 14.00.

All timings following departure are approximate, should the EUSA Campus reach capacity, the remainder of the Pride March will continue ahead from Crichton Street into George Square, turning left into Middle Meadow Walk, dispersing on the Meadows.
